Attendance dues are paid to the proprietors of Maranatha Christian School to pay for the on-going maintenance and development of the school buildings.

Other sundry expenses may be charged for teaching and learning programmes or any additional extra-curricular activities incurring extra costs. Parents will be notified of such expenses in advance.

One term's written notice of intention to withdraw your child(ren) from the school is required. Where no notice is given a fee of one term's attendance dues will be charged in lieu of notice.

All fees are payable within 14 days of the beginning of each school term.

Where attendance dues remain unpaid and no arrangement has been made (or arrangement has been dishonoured) with the Proprietors and/or Board of Trustees as to payment, the Proprietors and/or Board of Trustees may require the removal of child(ren) from the school. Any outstanding bus fees will incur a penalty charge of 10%. Where bus fees remain unpaid the removal of the child/ren from the bus may be required.

I agree that my personal information may be shared with a debt collection agency, in a case where my fees remain unpaid and no arrangement has been made. I acknowledge that I will be responsible for paying any costs incurred, without limitation, during the collection of any outstanding fees.

Maranatha Christian School reserves the right to request a copy of the bill-payers credit report from a credit bureau.

Voluntary Donations

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| 3. Voluntary Donations | \$110.00 per term per student |
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The voluntary donation payment is used to; cover basic student stationery, subsidise bus transport, e-learning equipment, other such expenditure as the Board considers necessary, which is not covered by Government grants. It also covers the school's Christian Curriculum material. A tax credit refund, (one third of the donation) can be claimed from IRD annually. To allow parents to claim this tax credit, a Donations Statement is sent out annually detailing the donations paid.
